



**ITT division here to merge with Va. Segment**

ITT Corp.'s Space Systems Division in Rochester will merge with its Virginia-based Night Vision segment to form a new division called Geospatial Systems.

The newly formed division will be based in Rochester and focus on providing networked sensors, such as next generation imaging.

Additional details on the merger were not immediately available. Reuters reported Tuesday the moves are expected to reduce ITT's global work force by 2 percent to 3 percent.

Space Systems has 1,650 local workers and ranked fourth on the Rochester Business Journal's most recent list of manufacturers.

The realignment was one of several in its defense segment announced by ITT Tuesday. The company's defense segment will be renamed ITT Defense and Information Solutions.

Its current organizational structure, comprising seven separate business units, will be consolidated into three larger ones. It does not affect the company's previously announced forecast for full-year 2010 earnings per share in the range of \$3.85 to \$4.05, company leaders said.
